Teaching and Research Faculty

1. PROFESSOR-CUM-DIRECTOR - 1 (Rs.16400-22000)

ESSENTIAL QUALIFICATIONS:

An eminent scholar with specialization in any branch of Social Sciences and Humanities subject with published work of high quality, actively engaged in research, with 10 years of experience in post graduate teaching, and/or experience of guiding research at doctoral level in the area of social exclusion and inclusive policy.

OR

An outstanding scholar with established reputation who has made significant contribution to knowledge in the field of Education, Health, Livelihood practices, market and social relations and put up a minimum of 5 years of service as Reader.

2. READER-CUM-DEPUTY DIRECTOR - 2 (Rs.12000-18300)

ESSENTIAL QUALIFICATIONS: . Ph.D. degree and research experience for a minimum of five(5) years in the area of social exclusion and inclusive policies. 2.The Master's degree should be in any branch of Social Sciences or Humanities

OR

Good academic record with a doctoral degree or equivalent published work in subjects of Social Sciences and Humanities. In addition to those, candidates who join from outside the university system, shall also possess at least 55% of the marks or an equivalent grade of B in the 7 point scale with letter grades O,A,B,C,D,E & F at the Master's degree level.

OR

Five years of experience of teaching and/or research, excluding the period spent for obtaining the research degrees and having made some mark in the areas of scholarship as evidenced by quality of publications, contribution to educational innovation, design of new courses and curricula.

3. LECTURER-CUM-ASSISTANT DIRECTOR - 3 (Rs.8000-13000)

ESSENTIAL QUALIFICATIONS: The Master' degree should be in any branch of Social Sciences or Humanities with A Ph.D. degree in the relevant subject and in the thrust areas of Health, Education, Dalits related to Social Exclusion and Inclusive Policies

Desirable: Knowledge of Computer Applications
Knowledge in Telugu Language

4. RESEARCH ASSOCIATE - 2 (Rs.12000 Plus HRA)

ESSENTIAL QUALIFICATIONS:

A candidate below the age of 45 years, who has doctorate degree in Social Science or humanities and published research work to his/her credit in the related field.

Knowledge in Telugu Language

ESSENTIAL QUALIFICATIONS: Master' degree in any branch of Social Sciences or Humanities with research experience in the areas related to social exclusion and inclusive policies. Knowledge of computer application in MS Office, Database Management , Internet and SPSS is preferred.

ESSENTIAL QUALIFICATIONS:

Bachelor's degree in Library and Information Science with experience in documentation and knowledge in Computer applications

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

The period of appointment of all posts in the advertisement mentioned are temporary in nature for a PERIOD OF FIVE YEARS during XI Plan period

Rule of Reservation will be followed (SC, ST, BC, women, PH, minorities).

Other things being equal, preference will be given to SCs, STs, OBCs and women.

1. Application should be in the prescribed form. Separate application for Teaching and Research Faculty and for Non-Teaching Post
2. Attested copies of certificates in evidence of age, community, (for SC/ST/BC/Ph candidates only), educational qualifications, experience should be enclosed with the application.
3. Candidates applying for more than one post should apply separately for each post. Application is not transferable.
4. Persons who are already employed should send their application(s) through proper channel. Advance copy may be sent directly. However, in such cases the candidates called for interview shall have to produce a No Objection Certificate or the original application duly forwarded by the competent authority, failing which he/she shall not be allowed to appear before the selection committee.
5. Two passport size photographs of the candidate should be enclosed, out of which one should be affixed in the application form and attested by a responsible officer.
6. Completed application with the required documents should be sent along with the registration fee(non-refundable) of Rs.200/- (for general) (for SC/ST candidates Rs.50/- on production of community certificate from the competent authority) by the Demand Draft dated not earlier than the date of the advertisement and payable at Andhra Bank, S.V. Puram, S.K. University-515 055 drawn in favour of the Registrar, S.K. University University, Anantapur -515 055, Andhra Pradesh.
7. Applications received without the registration fee shall be rejected.
8. Incomplete applications will be summarily rejected and applications received late will not at all be considered under any circumstances and no further correspondence will be made in this regard. The University will not be responsible for any postal delay.
9. Original certificate should not be sent along with the applications. If sent, the University is in no way responsible for any possible loss.
10. The original certificates should be produced at the time of interview for verification.
11. Before dispatching the application to the University the applicant should make note of the application number for the purpose of reference.
12. If there is any discrepancy between the information furnished in the application and the supporting documents such applications will be summarily rejected.
13. Canvassing in any form will disqualify the candidate.
14. The name of the post applied for shall be superscribed on the envelope.
15. Applicants for the post of Professor-cum-Director should submit their bio-data and four sets of reprints of three major publications, of which one could be a book or research report along with each application.
16. Applicants for the post of Reader-cum-Deputy Director should submit their bio-data and four sets of reprints of three major publications along with each application.
17. No TA/DA will be paid to candidates called for interview.
18. The University reserves the right to:
 - i. **To fill up/not to fill up any of the above posts;**
 - ii. **Relax the desirable qualifications in case of otherwise deserving candidates;**
 - iii. **Restrict the number of candidates to be called for interview to a reasonable level;**
 - iv. **To restrict the period of tenure already prescribed.**
19. An applicant cannot claim interview or appointment as a matter or right just because/he/she is an applicant for the post.

NOTE

1. A relaxation of 5% from 55% to 50% of the marks at the Master's level for the SC/ST category and Physically handicapped persons.
2. A relaxation of 5% to 50% of the marks for Ph.D degree holders who passed their Master's **degree prior to 19th September, 1991**.
3. B in the 7 point scale with letter grade O,A,B,C,D,E and F shall regarded as equivalent of 55% wherever the grading system is followed.
4. NET shall remain compulsory requirement for appointment as Lecturer-Cum-Assistant Director even for those with post-graduate degree. However, the candidates who have completed M.Phil degree upto 31st December 1993 or have submitted Ph.D thesis to the University in the concerned subject on or before 31st December 2002 are exempted from appearing in the NET examination. In case such candidates fail to obtain Ph.D degree, they shall have to pass the NET examinations.
5. The minimum requirement of 55% shall not be insisted upon for Professors and Readers for the existing incumbents who are already in the university system. However, these marks should be insisted upon for those entering the system from outside and those at the entry point of Lecturers.
6. A relaxation of the minimum marks at the PG level from 55% to 50% for appointment as Lecturer may be provided to the candidates who have cleared the JRF examination conducted by UGC/CSIR only prior to 1989, when the minimum marks required to appear for JRF exam were 50%.
